



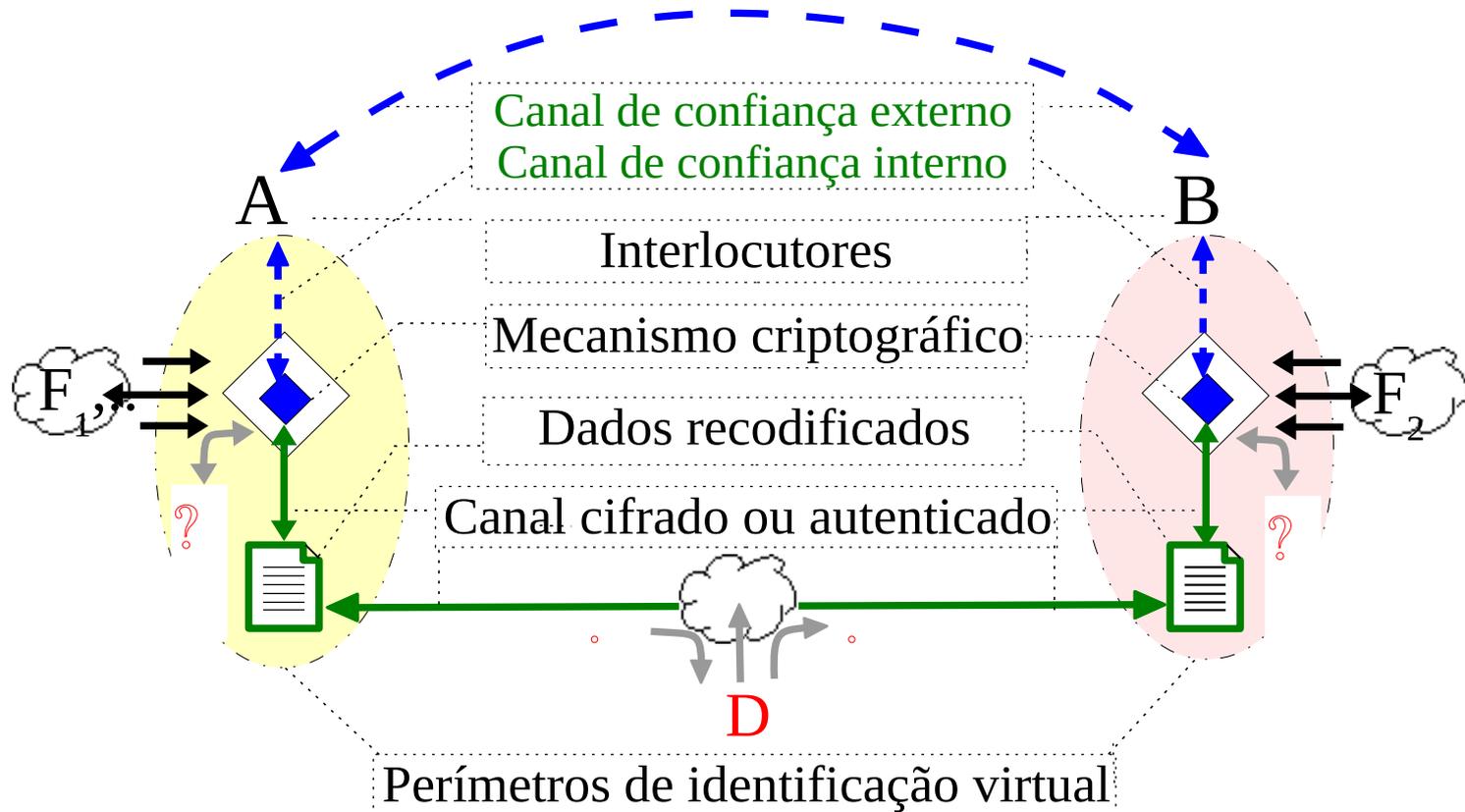

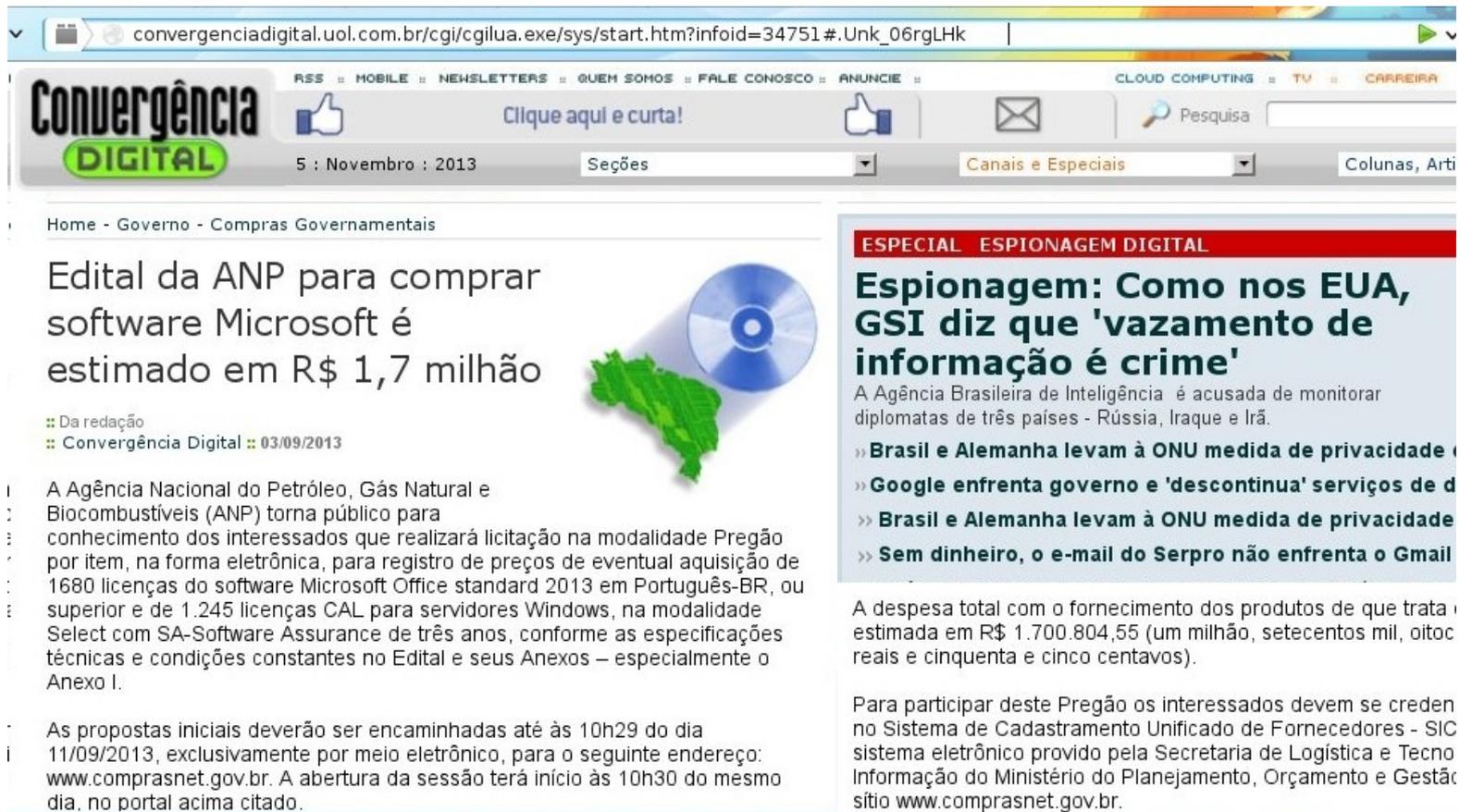

JEDDAH, Saudi Arabia (Reuters) — Saudi Arabia’s national oil company, Aramco, said on Sunday that a cyberattack against it in August that damaged some 30,000 computers was aimed at stopping oil and gas production in Saudi Arabia, the biggest exporter in the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries.

The attack on Saudi Aramco — which supplies a tenth of the world’s oil — failed to disrupt production, but was one of the most destructive hacker strikes against a single business.

“The main target in this attack was to stop the flow of oil and local and international markets and thank God they were not achieve their goals,” Abdullah al-Saadon, Aramco’s vice pres corporate planning, said on Al Ekhbariya television. It was A first comments on the apparent aim of the attack.

A review of classified US intelligence records has revealed that the CIA could not confirm the identity of about a quarter of the people killed by drone strikes in Pakistan from 2010 to 2011.

One key term in analyzing drone strike records are what are known as "*signature*" strikes, when drones kill suspects based on behavior patterns but without positive identification, versus "*personality*" strike. One former senior intelligence official said that at the height of the drone program in Pakistan in 2009 and 2010, as many as half of the strikes were classified as signature strikes.

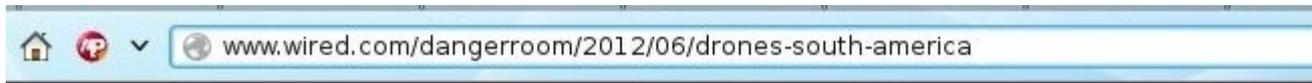

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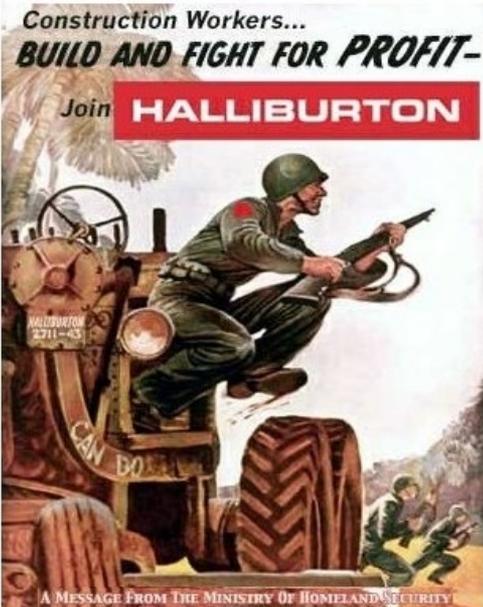
## The 25 Most Vicious Iraq War Profiteers

The Iraq war is many things to different people. It is called a strategic blunder and a monstrous injustice and sometimes even a patriotic mission, much to the chagrin of rational human beings. For many big companies, however, the war is something far different: a lucrative cash-cow. The following is a detailed rundown of the 25 companies squeezing the most profit from this controversial conflict.

### 1. Halliburton

The first name that comes to everyone's mind here is Halliburton. According to *MSN Money*, Halliburton's KBR, Inc. division bilked government agencies to the tune of \$17.2 billion in Iraq war-related revenue from 2003-2006 alone. This is estimated to comprise a whopping one-fifth of KBR's total revenue for the 2006 fiscal year.

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A Petrobras confirmou nesta quinta-feira que dados sigilosos sobre pesquisas sísmicas, que podem incluir a descoberta de petróleo e gás, foram furtados de um contêiner da empresa. **Abstract:**  
The audit market's unique combination of features – its role in capital market transparency, mandated demand, and concentrated supply – means it receives considerable attention from policymakers. We explore the effects of two market scenarios that have been the focus of policy discussions: a) further supply concentration due to one of the "Big 4" auditors exiting and b) mandatory audit firm rotation. To do so, we first estimate publicly traded firms' demand for auditing services, treating services provided by each of the Big 4 as differentiated products. We then use those estimates to calculate how each scenario would affect client firms' consumer surplus. We estimate that, conservatively, exit by one of the Big 4 would reduce client firms' surplus by \$1.2-1.8 billion per year.
